

**2019 OUTWARD BOUND CANADA 'ALUMNI RE-BOUND WEEKEND' CONTEST
OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES
("RULES")**

No Purchase Necessary

TO PARTICIPATE, YOU MUST BE THE AGE OF MAJORITY IN YOUR PROVINCE OF RESIDENCE AND HAVE COMPLETED 1 OUTWARD BOUND COURSE. OPEN TO RESIDENTS OF CANADA (EXCLUDING QUEBEC) ONLY.

You must have Internet access and a valid email address in order to participate.

1. CONTEST PERIOD

The 2019 Outward Bound Canada "Alumni Re-Bound Weekend" Contest (the "**Contest**") commences at 12:00:01 pm ET on March 6th 2019, and ends at 4.59.59 pm ET on April 17th, 2019 (the "**Contest Period**"). This contest is sponsored by Outward Bound Canada (the "**Contest Sponsor**"). All times referenced in these Rules are in Eastern Time ("**ET**").

2. ELIGIBILITY

The Contest is open to all legal residents of Canada, excluding residents of Quebec, who, at the time of Contest entry, have attained the age of majority in their jurisdiction of residence, and who have completed at least one (1) Outward Bound Canada course.

Entrants must submit information about which Outward Bound Canada course they attended and during which year to enter the Contest. This information is subject to verification and the Contest Sponsor reserves the right to reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to require proof of identity and/or eligibility (in a form acceptable to the Contest Sponsor – including, without limitation, government-issued photo identification) to participate in this Contest.

Notwithstanding the above, this Contest is not open to employees of the Contest Sponsor, its respective divisions, subsidiaries, affiliates, representatives, agents, advertising and promotional agencies, contest suppliers, members of their immediate families (parents, siblings, spouses) and those with whom they are domiciled.

By entering this Contest, you agree to be bound by these Rules, the Account Terms of Use and the decisions of the Contest Sponsor, which are final and binding on all entrants, without right of

appeal, with respect to all aspects of the Contest, including without limitation eligibility and/or disqualification of entrants and entries.

3. HOW TO ENTER

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. Internet access and a valid email address are required to enter the Contest. Although online access and an e-mail account are required in order to participate, no purchase is required in order to enter the Competition. Many public libraries, retail businesses and others offer free access to computers and a number of Internet service providers and other companies offer free e-mail accounts.

During the Contest Period:

- B. Complete the Contest entry form (the "Entry Form")
- C. Follow all online instructions in order to submit your Contest entry via the Entry Form. Entrants will be asked to complete the online Contest Entry Form by entering all required information, including his/her full name, e-mail, date of birth, phone number, and postal code as instructed, confirming his/her agreement to be bound by these Rules and clicking on "submit" to submit his/her entry. All fields on the Contest entry form must be completed unless indicated as optional.

All entries are subject to verification. The Contest Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to require proof of identity and/or eligibility (in a form acceptable to the Contest Sponsor – including, without limitation, government-issued photo identification) to participate in this Contest. Failure to provide such proof in a timely manner may result in disqualification, at the sole and absolute discretion of the Contest Sponsor. The sole determinant of the time for the purposes of a valid entry in this Contest will be the Contest server machine(s).

There is a limit of one (1) entry per person/e-mail address permitted and an individual can only use one (1) e-mail address to participate in the Contest. If it is discovered that any individual has attempted to: use (or attempt to use) multiple names, identities and/or more than one (1) email address to participate in the Contest; then (in the sole and absolute discretion of the Contest Sponsor) the individual may be disqualified from participating in the Contest and his/her entry(ies) may be disqualified. Use (or attempted use) of multiple names, identities, email addresses and/or any automated system to participate in this Contest is prohibited and is grounds for disqualification.

In the event of a dispute as to who submitted an entry(ies), the Contest Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to deem the entry(ies) to have been submitted by the

authorized account holder of the email address submitted. "Authorized Account Holder" is defined as the natural person who is assigned to an email address by an Internet access provider, on-line service provider or other organization (e.g., business, educational institution, etc.) that is responsible for assigning email addresses for the domain associated with the submitted email address. The selected entrant may be required to provide the Contest Sponsor with proof that he/she is the authorized account holder of the email address associated with the Account user profile.

The Contest Parties and their respective agents, employees, directors, successors, and assigns (collectively, the "Releasees") are not responsible for late, lost, garbled, misdirected, delayed, incomplete or incompatible Entries, or Entries that are processed late or incorrectly or are lost due to computer or electronic malfunction or other error.

4. PRIZING

Limit one Prize per person.

There are ten (10) Ontario based Grand Prizes, and ten (10) British Columbia based Grand Prizes available to be won in the Contest.

The ten Ontario based Grand Prizes available to be won in the Contest consists of a 3-day Outward Bound Canada Re-bound Weekend course offered between June 21st-23rd, 2019 for one person (who must also be a legal resident of Canada (excluding Quebec), and have reached the age of majority in his/her province or territory of residence at or prior to the time of participation in the course).

The ten British Columbia based Grand Prizes available to be won in the Contest consists of a 3-day Outward Bound Canada Re-bound Weekend course offered between June 28th-30th, 2019 for one person (who must also be a legal resident of Canada (excluding Quebec), and have reached the age of majority in his/her province or territory of residence at or prior to the time of participation in the course).

The Grand Prizes are limited to the cost of the Outward Bound Canada course only. Transportation to and from the course start and finish location is not included in the prize and must be provided by the winner.

The retail value of the Grand Prize is \$800.

The Grand Prize must be accepted as awarded and is not transferable or convertible to cash at the winner's option. No substitutions except at Contest Sponsor's sole option. Contest Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to substitute the Grand Prize or a component thereof with a prize of equal value, including, without limitation, but at Contest Sponsor's sole and absolute discretion, a cash award.

Without limiting the foregoing, the following general conditions apply to the Grand Prizes: (i) participants must attend an Alumni Re-Bound Weekend course on either June 21st-23rd (Ontario) or June 28th-30th (British Columbia) (ii) all courses related to the Grand Prize must occur within the dates specified above (otherwise the Grand Prize will be forfeited in its entirety); (iii) the winner must: (a) have all necessary documentation to permit course attendance including passing a medical screening outlined by Outward Bound Canada and; (iv) the costs of everything not specifically stated above as included in the Grand Prize are the sole responsibility of the winner, including, without limitation: health and travel insurance; transportation to and from the course start location which may include travel to the Canadian international airport nearest the winner's residence if required; clothing/accessory purchases based on the Outward Bound Canada's recommended packing list, excess baggage fees; fuel/currency surcharges; and all items of a personal; (v) if the winner does not utilize any part(s) of the Grand Prize, then any such part(s) not utilized will be forfeited in their entirety and nothing will be substituted in their place; (vi) Contest Sponsor reserves the right at any time to place reasonable restrictions on the availability or use of the Grand Prize or any component thereof; (vii) all course arrangements relating to the Grand Prize must be made through the Contest Sponsor or its designated agents; (viii) by accepting the Grand Prize, the winner agrees to waive all recourse against the Releasees if the Grand Prize or a component thereof does not prove satisfactory, either in whole or in part.

5. JUDGING CRITERIA

Entries will be judged on the originality, quality and content of the submission, including the extent to which the entrant has reflected authentically on their Outward Bound experience, its subsequent impact on their life, and their reasons for wanting to participate in an Outward Bound Canada Re-Bound Weekend.

The judges have the right to reject any submission that contains inappropriate language.

Between April 18th and April 25th, 2019 the judging process will take place (the "Judging Period"). All eligible entries will be judged by a judging panel (the "Judging Panel" selected by the Sponsor. The Judging Panel will select ten (10) entries eligible for the Ontario-based Grand Prize (as indicated by the contest entrant as a preference) and ten (10) entries for the British Columbia-based Grand Prize (as indicated by the contest entrant as a preference). The judges reserve the right not to award all Grand Prizes and their decision is final.

The Contest Sponsor or its designated representative will make a minimum of three (3) attempts to contact each selected entrant by phone or email (using the information provided by such entrant on his/her Contest entry form) within five (5) business days following the end of the Judging Period.

In the event that a potential winner cannot be contacted for any reason within five (5) business days of the end of the “Judging Period”; then that potential winner will be disqualified (and will forfeit all rights to a Grand Prize) and the Contest Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to select an alternate eligible entrant from among the remaining eligible entries (in which case the foregoing provisions of this section shall apply to such new selected potential winner, with appropriate adjustment of the timeframe from the date of alternative selection).

6. WINNER CONDITIONS:

Before being declared a Grand Prize winner, the selected entrant must: (i) correctly answer, unaided, a mathematical skill-testing question to be administered, at the sole and absolute discretion of the Contest Sponsor, either over the phone by a representative of Outward Bound Canada, or in the Declaration and Release form referred to below; and (ii) and complete, sign and return the Contest Sponsor’s form of Declaration and Release Form (and any other documents, as applicable) by the date indicated on the Declaration and Release Form (the “Prize Claim Date”). The Grand Prize must be claimed by the Prize Claim Date. If the selected entrant cannot be reached within the timeframe specified above, is not in compliance with these Rules, incorrectly answers the skill-testing question, declines the prize, or fails to return the Declaration and Release Form (and any other documents, as applicable) by the Prize Claim Date, or if email correspondence between the Contest Sponsor and selected entrant is returned as undeliverable without a forwarding address, then, at the sole and absolute discretion of the Contest Sponsor, such selected entrant may be disqualified and his/her claim to the Grand Prize forfeited, and the Contest Sponsor reserves the right to select another entrant from the remaining eligible entries.

7. GENERAL

The Contest Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, and without prior notice, to adjust any of the dates and/or time frames stipulated in these Rules, to the extent necessary, for purposes of verifying compliance by any entrant or entry with these Rules, or as a result of technical problems, or in light of any other circumstances which, in the opinion of the Contest Sponsor, in its sole and absolute discretion, affect the proper administration of the Contest as contemplated in these Rules.

(2) The decisions of the Contest Sponsor are final and binding on all entrants, without right of appeal, with respect to all aspects of the Contest, including without limitation eligibility and/or disqualification of entrants and entries, and entrant agrees to abide by all of the instructions and decisions of the Contest Sponsor. In the event of any dispute regarding the interpretation of these Rules, the decision or interpretation of the Contest Sponsor shall prevail.

(3) No communications will be entered into except with the selected entrant.

(4) All entries become the property of the Contest Sponsor. Any entry that is incomplete, altered or contains false information is invalid. Contest Sponsor is not responsible for lost, stolen, delayed, damaged or misdirected claims or entries or for any problems or technical malfunction of any internet or telephone network or broadcast transmission during the Contest Period. The Contest Sponsor is not responsible for any errors or omissions with respect to the printing or advertising of this Contest. If, for any reason whatsoever, Contest Sponsor determines in its sole discretion that this Contest is no longer capable of running as intended, Contest Sponsor may in its sole discretion withdraw, amend, cancel or modify this Contest in any way.

8. LIABILITY AND RELEASE

The Contest Sponsor accepts no responsibility for loss, damage or claims caused by the awarded prizes or the Contest itself. By entering the Contest, all entrants forever release and hold harmless the Contest Sponsor and its respective affiliated and related companies, advertising and promotional agencies and all of their respective directors, officers, shareholders, employees, representatives, agents, successors and assigns (collectively, the "Contest Entities") from any and all liability for any injuries, loss, death, or damage of any kind arising from or in connection with the Contest or any prize won.

Without limiting the release of liability provisions herein, and for greater certainty, the Contest Entities will not be liable for: a) any incorrect or inaccurate information, whether caused by Contest Website or Application users or by any equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Contest or by any technical or human error which may occur in the processing of entries in the Contest; b) any error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect or delay in operation of the Contest Website or Application or any transmission in connection with the Contest; c) any communications line failure, theft, destruction or unauthorized access to, or alteration of, entries; d) any problems with, or technical malfunction of, any telephone network or lines, computer online systems, servers or providers, computer equipment, software, or failure of email which may occur for any reason whatsoever, including technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet or at any website or combination thereof; or e) any injury or damage to entrants' or to any other person's computer related to or resulting from participating or downloading materials in this Contest.

9. TAMPERING

The Contest Sponsor reserves the right in their sole discretion to disqualify any individual from the Contest, and to ban the individual from any future promotion of the Contest Sponsor, if the Contest Sponsor finds or believes such individual to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Contest or where applicable, the Contest Website; to be acting in violation of

the Rules or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner, or with intent to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass the Contest Sponsor, the Contest Sponsor's agencies, other entrants or any other

person. ANY ATTEMPT BY AN ENTRANT OR ANY OTHER PERSON TO DELIBERATELY DAMAGE ANY WEBSITE OR UNDERMINE THE LEGITIMATE OPERATION OF THE CONTEST IS A VIOLATION OF CRIMINAL AND CIVIL LAWS AND SHOULD SUCH AN ATTEMPT BE MADE, THE CONTEST SPONSOR RESERVES THE RIGHT TO SEEK DAMAGES FROM ANY SUCH PERSON TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW.

10. PUBLICITY

By entering this Contest, each entrant agrees that the Contest Sponsor and its respective designees may use the entrant's name, photograph, likeness, address, biographical information, prize information and/or statements about this Contest for advertising and/or publicity purposes in any and all media now or hereafter known throughout the world in perpetuity without compensation, notification, or permission, unless otherwise prohibited by law. This includes being able to use entrant's information and photographs for promotional purposes during and after the Re-Bound Weekends (Grand Prize).

11. GOVERNING LAW AND INTERPRETATION

This Contest and its Rules shall be governed by Ontario law and all participants expressly agree that the Ontario courts shall have sole jurisdiction over any dispute or litigation arising from or relating to this Contest and agree to submit to the laws of and the jurisdiction of the federal courts and provincial courts of the Province of Ontario, and hereby waive the jurisdiction of any other court that now or in the future could be considered competent for any reason. The venue shall only be Toronto, Ontario. The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of these Rules shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision. In the event that any provision is determined to be invalid or otherwise unenforceable or illegal, these Rules shall otherwise remain in effect and shall be construed in accordance with their terms as if the invalid or illegal provision were not contained herein.

12. PERSONAL INFORMATION

Personal information provided on the Contest entry form by entrants is collected by the Contest Sponsor for the purpose of administering this Contest and for advertising and/or publicity purposes as described in section 10 of these Rules. You understand that you are providing your information to the Contest Sponsor. Any questions, comments or complaints regarding the Contest should be directed to the Contest Sponsor.

By participating in this Contest, each entrant expressly consents to the Contest Sponsor, its agents and/or representatives, storing, sharing and using the personal information submitted with his/her entry in this Contest only for the purpose of administering the Contest.
